



*In Texas Shootout™, you receive four (4) cards and may select two (2) cards to play, or split the four (4) cards into two 2-card hands. The dealer will present five (5) additional community cards that all the players and the dealer use in combination with their two (2) cards to make their best 5-card poker hand. Six (6) standard decks of 52 cards are used and are dealt from a shoe by the dealer.*

*The minimum and maximum wagers will be posted at the table. The bonus minimum and maximum wagers will also be posted at the table.*

### **Ranking of Hands**

### **How to Play**

After all players have placed their wagers, the dealer deals four (4) cards to each player. You decide which two (2) of the four (4) cards you want to play, and discard the unused cards. You may elect to play two (2) 2-card hands, provided you bet an equal amount on each hand. The dealer must now determine which two (2) cards they wish to play. Next, the dealer deals five (5) cards, face up, in the center of the table. These five (5) cards are community cards and are used by all the players at the table, including the dealer. The object of the game is to have a higher ranking 5-card poker hand than the dealer.

If there is a tie, all five (5) cards have the same ranking — the player loses. Players, at house discretion, may play MORE than one hand.

Equal amounts of money must be bet on both hands, excluding the bonus bet. You may wager less on the bonus.



## Bonuses

In addition to your regular poker hand bet, you have the option to place a side-bet before the hand is dealt. (Note Shootout Bonus Table, below)

Minimum side-bet is \$1. Aggregate payout per round is \$25,000.

If your bonus bet is at least \$5, you automatically qualify for the Envy Bonus, which pays you if ANY PLAYER, excluding the dealer or your own matching shootout bonus, has Five-of-a-Kind or higher (Note Bonus Payout Table below).

### Shootout Bonus Paytable

HAND	PAYS
Five-of-a-Kind, Suited .....	1,000 to 1
Royal Flush .....	200 to 1
Straight Flush .....	75 to 1
Five-of-a-Kind .....	40 to 1
Four-of-a-Kind .....	7 to 1
Full House .....	3 to 1
Flush .....	2 to 1
Straight .....	2 to 1

*To qualify for the Shootout Bonus, make your side-bet wager before the hand is dealt.*

### Envy Bonus Payouts

HAND	PAYS
Five-of-a-Kind, Suited .....	\$1,000
Royal Flush .....	\$250
Straight Flush .....	\$50
Five-of-a-Kind .....	\$10

*Only the highest hand of each round qualifies for the Envy Bonus.*
